If you have missed out Dec 2006 near Christmas Similans trip, here is your chance not to miss it again.

Similans, Koh Bon, Koh Tachai and Richelieu Rock

The Similan islands are a string of nine granite islands, providing breathtaking scenery above and below the water. The Similans are more famous for their rocky dive sites. Enormous granite bolder formations form numerous swim-thrus, gullies and canyons.

The islands are fringed by extensive coral reefs and home to a multitude of tropical fish, with frequent sightings of turtles, rays and sharks. Visibility year round averages 30 metres with a sea temperature of 27 - 29oC. All this makes the Similans attractive for both divers and snorkellers alike.

The most popular Similan dive sites are: Elephant Head Rock, Christmas Point, East of Eden, The Ridge, Breakfast Bend, Three Trees, Boulder City, Shark Fin Reef and Anita's Reef.

Worldwide known as the ultimate spot for whale shark diving in the Andaman Sea, Richelieu Rock has much more to offer than "just" big fish encounters. These pinnacles rise from 40 meters of depth up to the surface but can only be seen during low tide. The pinnacles are completely covered in an amazing variety of beautifully colored soft

corals.

The abundance of marine life will satisfy even the most demanding diver. Camouflage experts such as sea horses, harlequin shrimps, anglerfish, pipefish are all found here. Giant groupers can be found in the deep and nurse sharks, turtles and barracuda are all regular visitors. Lionfish, emperor angelfish, scorpion fish, trevallies and glassfish can be found in large numbers. Between January and April, the chances to meet whale sharks are higher than anywhere else in Southeast Asia.

***Suggested Itinerary:**

Jan 15 (Tue) Meet at Budget Terminal 11.50pm Tiger Airway TR 154 Departing 1.50pm. Arrive 2.45 at Phuket Airport, transfer to (transport not included in package) Kata Beach Dive Center, free and easy till 8pm. Pick up at dive center 8pm, transfer to Tap Lamu (2hrs ride) to board MV White Manta (Transfer included in package)

Jan 16 (Wed) 4 dives at Anita reef, East of Eden, Elephant Head Rock and Turtle bay

Jan 17 (Thurs) 4 dives at Christmas tree point, North Point Snapper Alley, Koh Bon.

Jan 18 (Fri) 3 dives at Richelieu rock, night dive at Koh Tachai.

Jan 19 (Sat) 2 dives at Ko Bon Pinnacle and Boon Sung wreck. Arrive 3pm at Tap Lamu, transfer to hotel.

Jan 20 (Sun) Free & easy. Transfer to Airport. Depart 3.05pm with Tiger Airways TR155 and arrive Singapore @ 5.45pm.
